OPENING OF THE SACRED HEART CHURCH FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

Instructions to follow when coming in to church

In order to keep everyone safe when coming to church, the following guidelines will need to be followed;

- Please apply hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the church, either your own or use the one provided inside the entrance to the Church
- There is a one way system in operation, enter through the main doors and exit via the fire door on the left of the Altar
- Please remember to observe 2 metre social distancing at all times unless you are from the same household
- Please only sit on the plastic seats at the front of the church
- The toilets and the hall must remain closed.
- Remember to take all your belongings home with you when you leave the church
- Anyone who is unwell or shielding and anyone in the “vulnerable” category is asked not to enter at the current time
- If you wish to leave a donation there are baskets at the entrance and exit.
