Thought for the Week

A 2010 novel by Emma Donoghue has the brief title of Room, it tells the story of a mother who is imprisoned in a garden shed together with her young son, Jack. The boy has always lived in the shed and has experienced the outside world only through a small skylight and on a TV screen. When his mother tells him that there is a whole wonderful world outside the shed he does not believe her. He feels safe in the confined space of the room and is afraid of change. But finally the boy escapes and discovers the beauty and immensity of this larger world.

What is the point of this image which the novel gives us? It is a way of helping us to understand Advent, which is about the coming of Christ. The problem is that Advent is often imprisoned in the world of shopping and the commercial build-up to Christmas. Recorded carols and shopping trips anticipate the feast of Mary's boy child in Bethlehem. So each year on the first Sunday of Advent the church calls us out of the narrow protected world where we are reluctant to change into the wider world of God's coming.

CARITAS HOMES WITHOUT BORDERS FOR REFUGEES —

NOVEMBER 2020 UPDATE recently, the Home Office have advised that inbound flights, bringing refugees to the UK, are to resume in early 2021. This is very welcome news, as the preparatory work of Community Sponsor groups such as ours, have been on hold due to Covid:19 which has prevented refugees being allowed to enter the UK. The decision by the Government, under the existing resettlement scheme, will allow 232 refugees to enter the UK although it is only those groups who have secured a property, who will be welcoming these refugees. Groups, such as ours, who have not secured a property yet, still do not have a date for when they will welcome a family to resettle. Hopefully, it won't be too long before we can start the search in earnest for a property that will help transform the lives of a suffering refugee family beyond their imagination. Please continue to pray for the success our project.

ATTENDING PUBLIC MASS AT SACRED HEART CHURCH

We need to observe the following guidelines when attending Mass:

Our intention is to celebrate Mass reverently and safely as a community of Christ's disciples.



The dispensation from Sunday Mass obligation remains in effect. Please don't register for Mass or enter the church if you or someone in your household has a temperature, a cough, flu-like symptoms or loss of taste or smell.

Stay at home and participate in the Mass via our live stream



Please bring your own face covering.

You must wear it at all times, except when receiving Holy Communion

Arrive at the front main doors of the church no later than **15 minutes before Mass** and if possible a bit before that.



Apply hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the church.

Either bring your own or use the dispenser provided inside the entrance to the church



Follow the instructions of the ushers. They will direct you to where to sit. -

Couples, or families of 3 or more from the same household, may sit together. Please do not kneel, sit in the marked places as directed by the stewards and please observe social distancing at all times.

Please keep young children with you at all times



Queuing to receive **Holy Communion** will be single file and it will be under one kind.

Follow the instructions given regarding when to come forward and receive Holy Communion so that social distancing is maintained

These measures are to make sure everyone feels safe when attending church. Let us all work together, follow the guidelines and be considerate of each other as we celebrate together in thanksgiving to God for the gift of the Eucharist.

HOW TO BOOK FOR MASS

- Due to the limited space in our church, booking is required for each of the Sunday Masses and the Wednesday Mass.
- Booking for Mass is organized by Jan our parish administrator.
- Booking closes on the Thursday at 1.30pm for Weekend Mass and on Tuesday for the Wednesday Mass.
 Places are limited so it will be first come first served, however those applying when bookings are full or closed can be booked immediately onto the following week.
- Booking is by email at hello@sacredhearthook.org. Please title the email "Mass booking", the date of the Mass and your surname and give the name, address and contact details of all who will be attending including of all those in a family group.
- Don't forget to indicate which Mass you will be attending. Mass is at 6pm on Saturday evening and at 10.00 am on Sunday morning or 10.00am on Wednesday morning.
- You will receive an email during Friday with confirmation and more instructions for the weekend Mass and on Tuesday afternoon for the Wednesday Mass.
- The names and contact details of everyone attending Mass will be recorded for NHS Track and Trace. These will be kept securely for 21 days and then destroyed.
- If you are unable to email the office, please contact Jan in the Parish Office on 07719012955 before 1.30pm on Thursday.
- Please make sure you are registered with the parish. If you think that you aren't (last census was 6 years ago) please fill in a registration form and return it to the parish office.
