



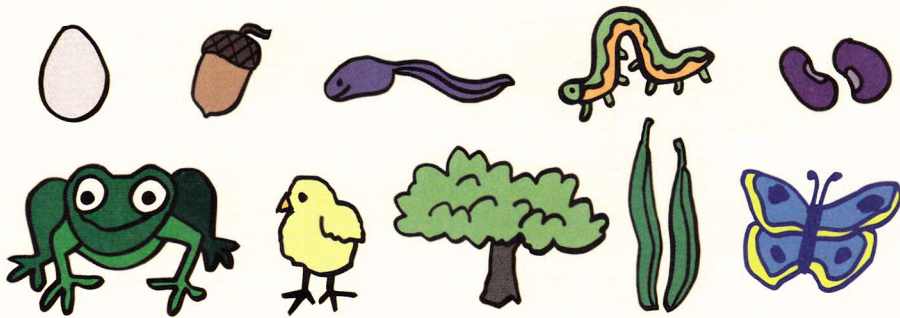

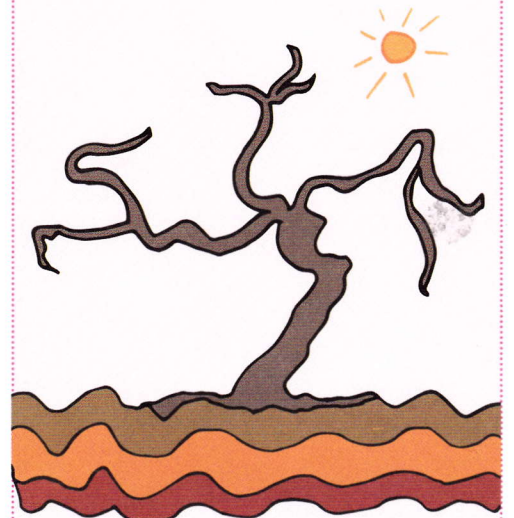
BE GENEROUS!

Most things change with time. Draw a line from each of these pictures to show what they grow into.



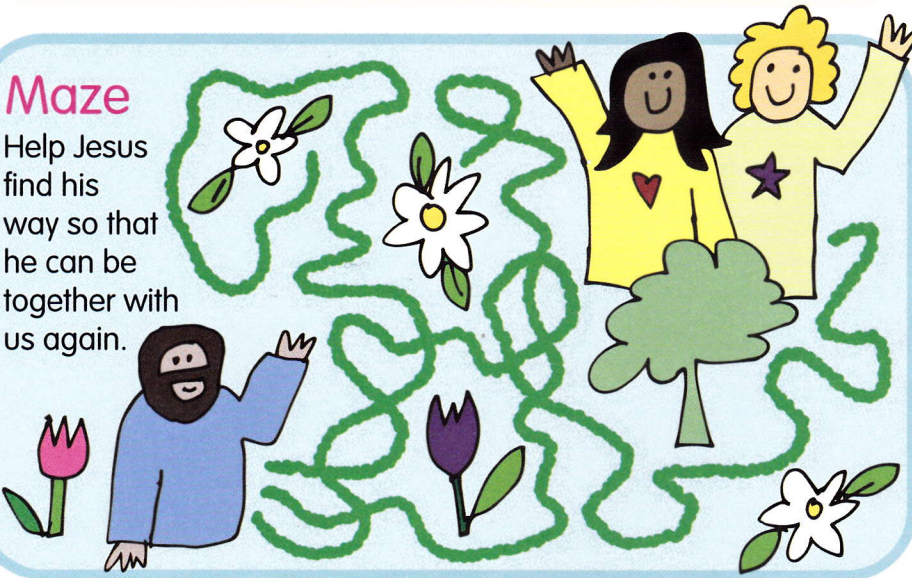
