	with those booking for Mass, booking for funerals and baptisms, and other events. We will also look to add this to the census which will also be sent out. We will also provide notices so those who do not want to be captured will know which rows of pews to sit in to avoid video capture. The camera will also	

	be able to zoom and focus on other areas if need be during communion.  At present using our old set up only those who are on the altar will be captured, i.e. Fr Paul and any readers.  Fr P mentioned that Vicki from Southampton has been working with the church there in regards to safeguarding and GDPR and she would be happy to offer any help. Fr P, Jan, Maggie and Joan will be following up with Vicki. ## Appendix 1

## Safeguarding in respect of children and vulnerable adults and live streaming services

Portsmouth Diocese have asked for guidance from the Catholic Safeguarding Advisory Service and are awaiting further input.

## Considerations to be looked into

- Children who are in the care of the local authority or have a 'looked after' status being identified.
- Parishioners who may be subject of a safeguarding plan and/or management by statutory agencies being identified.
- Victims of domestic abuse being identified.
- Those who may be subject of a protection by statutory agencies being identified.
- Accommodate those who do not wish to be filmed.
- Being able to track and identify whose images have been used and when.

We will need to advise parishioners in advance and before a service that it is being live streamed Altar servers under 16 will need a consent form signed by the parents or guardians to agree to being filmed We know some churches live stream but fix the view so that it is only the priest/adult clergy that are seen. Perhaps this is an option for us?

The Diocese recently received a letter from the police/probation and offender management agencies reminding faith groups of the need to ensure safeguarding considerations are at the forefront when considering live streaming.

Alongside awaiting a response from CSAS, the Diocese are also awaiting a response from the local Safeguarding Children's Partnership to see if they can offer any advice regarding this.
