<p>Parish Mission and Evangelisation</p>		<p>Fr Paul forwarded an email advising about a need for some representative from the parish to take part in the evangelisation initiative. A subgroup has been formed with Joan, Grania and Theresa to look at the global evangelisation efforts that the diocese wishes for us to implement. Several seminars are in place and once that's been completed we will report back our findings and discuss how we take this forward and how to engage with the parish. Fr Mark Hogan leading the diocesan efforts.</p>
<p>Community Outreach program</p>		<p>Fr Paul wanted to have this up and running to ensure during the 2nd wave of covid that some parishioners don't fall through the cracks as he's been making phone calls to those vulnerable during the initial lockdown period. We have engaged with various members of the parish and Helena together with</p>

		<p>Theresa, Grania, Anne Da Silva, Glenys have volunteered to steer this group. Initially starting with making regular phone calls to the list of people who are lonely, in care homes, in hospital etc. Reaching out to chat or ask if they need any help, shopping etc. Maggie to advise DBS checks. We will also put this in the newsletter and see if anyone else in the parish would like to volunteer. Fr Paul to provide list of names and contacts that he wishes for us to pick up and to reach out initially to introduce this group and obtain consent to allow the members to contact them.</p>
<p>Social Justice and Peace Initiative</p>		<p>This initiative was lead by the Bishop and he wants the parishes to support and tackle the homelessness, poor, and slavery in our area. Modern slavery is active in Hampshire in places like nail bars and car washes. Grania is leading this project as she attended the talk with the Bishop held at St Bedes. We will be researching into what other parishes have done and how we can support this. We will also be advertising this group and asking for volunteers to assist in implementing these plans so we can involve the parish. We will also be leaning into the good work Brita and Hannah are already doing for Caritas and helping the poor and homeless, the refugee program. Fr Paul to also discuss with the pastor at the Life Church and get his views on this.</p>
<p>Review of the PPC efforts in 2020</p>		<p>We would like to have a “bumper edition” of the newsletter, highlighting to the parishioners what we have done since our formation.
