The Funeral Mass, which took place in St Peter's Square Rome on Thursday 5th January at 9:30am (8:30am UK time) was celebrated by Pope Francis.

This weekend, Bishop Philip will be issuing a Pastoral Letter. It's called "Pope Benedict XVI" and in many ways is a personal thanksgiving to God for the gift of the life of the Pope Emeritus and his impact upon our Bishop.

SIX HOLY HABITS

Bishop Philip is inviting each one of us to develop six holy habits for this time of change and deep personal renewal:

- · to keep Sunday special, a family day, by attending Mass;
- · to spend 5 minutes a day in prayer using the Scriptures;
- · to do penance on Fridays, and to serve the poor and needy;
- · every fortnight to make a Holy Half Hour before the Blessed Sacrament;
- · to go to Confession once a month;
- · to join a small group for formation, prayer and fellowship.

PEACE SUNDAY

Each year, Peace Sunday gives every parish the chance to pray and reflect on the Pope's Message for the annual World Day of Peace. This year the Sunday designated by the Bishops of England and Wales as Peace Sunday is **Sunday 15th January**. In his Message this year, Pope Francis reflects on coming out of the COVID pandemic and the war in Ukraine. He urges all of us to embark together on paths to peace. The full text is on the Pax Christi website www.paxchristi.org.uk. All resources for marking Peace Sunday can also be found there, including a Liturgy Booklet, a 3 minute Peace Sunday talk and resources for children. These and other resources are all downloadable. Peace Sunday is also an opportunity to donate to Pax Christi, the International Catholic Movement for Peace, who, together with the Bishops, prepare the resources for Peace Sunday each year.
