- Victoria's Promise is a local charity dedicated to supporting young women, aged 25-50, diagnosed with cancer. When Victoria was diagnosed with a rare and aggressive cancer at just 29 years of age, she asked one thing of her family "Promise me you'll help others through this." We offer full services to young women, and their families, who are diagnosed or treated at Basingstoke and North Hants Hospital, The Royal County Hospital, Winchester and now Frimley Park Hospital. Our In Person Support & Services provide essential support, including home visits, VP meetings (for the young women to meet others on the same journey, providing essential connections with others who truly understand) as well as providing additional services such as complementary therapies to ease treatment side effects, nutritional advice or counselling for the woman and/or their children. These services are tailored to each individual women to ensure we support her specific needs. #### Trinity – Year C – 2025 – Hook

"In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me."

God has no desire to be separated from us, ever. Just as Jesus was physically present to the Disciples, the Lord continues to be present to us through His Spirit. The Trinity celebrates the sacredness of relationship, Father with the Son, in the power of the Holy Spirit. If God exists and operates in relationship, so must we, if we are to reflect God's image and likeness. **We meet God when we relate**, when we connect with others.

I met God a few days ago in Joan. Years ago, she lost her son, to be followed shortly afterwards by her husband. A few days ago, she lost her daughter Anne. "Why shouldn't it be me?" she exclaimed. She seemed unshakeable, just like God is, unshakeable. Such faith!

I met God in Siobahn, Anne's sister. Turns out she is one of the top ophthalmic surgeons in the country, yet completely and utterly unassuming about it. Her humility shone. God's Spirit shone.

I met God in Gloria living her final days. As I anointed her, she said, "you have such a lovely face." Despite the temptation to be a little egotistical, I absolutely knew she was seeing someone else, our Blessed Lord. I watched the Lord give her His peace.

I met God in Ryan, soon to be Fr Ryan, on a Traveller site the other week. He disappeared for over two hours. He just wanted to connect with God's people, how Grace works, the Good Shepherd in action.

So, a Christian must be someone who is prepared to connect with other people. Yes, there are risks attached. Yes, we will need to be courageous at times. Yes, we will get hurt sometimes, **but relate we must**, if we are in any way serious about a relationship with God.

#### John 16:12-16

"I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you. Jesus went on to say, "In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me."
