Dear Friends,

My name is Fr. Fergal Maguire SS.CC., and I am a member of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. I come from Dublin, Ireland, and have had the privilege of ministering in Africa, Spain, the Americas, and within parish communities in the Southwark and Westminster dioceses. I have also served as chaplain at the Heathrow Detention Centre and currently have the blessing of serving as chaplain to the traveling communities for the Diocese of Westminster.

I am delighted to be invited to Sacred Heart Parish to lead your Advent Day of Reflection. I understand that the runup to Christmas can be a busy time for us all, but I hope you will be able to join us for this special day. During the day, we will focus on themes such as "Finding Stillness in a Busy World," "Meeting God in Solitude and Silence," with talks titled "You Can't Hurry Love." And "The Naked Prophet". Throughout the day we will pause, engage in reflective talks, and have opportunities for mindfulness and meditation, allowing time for personal prayer and reflection and have a shared lunch. This day aims to help us prepare our hearts for Christmas, embracing hope, peace, and renewal as we journey through Advent.

The day will begin at 10:30am in the parish hall, where tea and coffee will be available. For lunch we will be serving soup & a roll in the hall. The reflection will conclude mid-afternoon, allowing time for a break before the evening Mass. If it's more convenient, I will also celebrate Mass on Sunday morning at 10:00am.

I look forward to meeting as many parishioners as possible on Saturday, 13th December, or at the Masses over the weekend.

First Sunday of Advent – Year A – 2025 – Hook

Are You Ready? I had just finished my Christmas dinner at a parishioner's house in Abingdon when my mobile phone went off. "Are you ready Fr John?" The caller was from another family who had invited me to have Christmas lunch with them months before. I had completely forgotten! "Sort of," was my reply. Fortunately, the second family was just around the corner. I had ten minutes to 'prepare' for another Christmas dinner! Today we begin the season of Advent heeding the Lord's advice to be ready. But what does readiness actually mean? When I hear the word 'ready' I always think of 'ready meals', quick, easy, conveniently packaged meals with minimum effort. Suffice to say, Jesus doesn't point us to quick and easy convenience. He points us in the opposite direction, to be thoughtfully and deliberately prepared to follow Him.

For weeks now we have reflected on what and it means to live the life of blessedness, 'the how' of the Beatitudes. Today, the Lord shifts our attention to 'the when'. He warns us away from procrastination, putting off our discipleship to another day. No, the life of blessedness is lived every single day as if it were my last. We are to seize every opportunity to be Christ for others, instinctively, spontaneously. We hunger — another facet of what readiness means - for opportunities to allow God's Grace to move in and through us into the lives of others. Six days ago, I was called into Southampton General Hospital to baptise three days old Michael in the Neo-natal ICU department. It was the fastest baptism in the west, for understandable reasons. Having poured three drops of water on his head, I invited Mum and Dad to join me in praying the Our Father. When we started to pray, I began to notice all the staff on the ward also praying. It was a magical moment of Grace, heaven descending to earth, spontaneous, instinctive, discipleship. This week we pray that we will seize every opportunity to be ready to love, without thinking, all of the time.
