#### What does Gaudete mean?

Gaudete means "rejoice" in Latin. Why do we light a pink candle on Gaudete Sunday? The Catholic Church uses the colour rose to indicate a joyful feast day or holiday. Gaudete Sunday's counterpart in Lent is Laetare Sunday, another break in penance to rejoice in hope as we approach Easter. During both days, a priest will usually wear rose vestments.




# Parish of the Sacred Heart – Advent Day of Reflection Date: Saturday, 13th December Time: 10:30am – 4:00pm
